Club Renewals.





Welcome to the May edition of our magazine.



You can take the family to the beach for fish & chips or whatever else you like but the Log Book must be filled in (in ink) before you take the car out of the garage. You can travel interstate for up to 3 months but each day on the road must be log-booked. Maintenance runs for your vehicle or runs to the RMS for rego etc. don't need to be log-booked provided it is within a 'reasonable distance' from where the car is garaged. Up to 10 or 15ks would be the limit. The police have been checking log books so make sure you fill it in. Also, carrying evidence of a club run in the car during an event is a good practice.

All GM Day at the Museum Of Fire - Penrith











It was very early in 1970 when Dorothy Mathews of Ryde got her car license for the first time approaching 40 years of age. With a license came the requirement for a car and being a die- hard Holden family off they went to the local Holden dealership – Pat Cullen Holden.

Buying the first brand new car for the family was a big thing so they decided if they were going to get a new car they would order exactly what they wanted. The HT Holden had only been out for months but it was soon decided it was the model for them. It was here that the tragic decision was made to go for the Kingswood rather than the Monaroe for the convenience of four doors. (sigh)

However they did love the look of the earlier Red HK Monaroes and decided on placing a special order rather than choosing from the lot. Optioned to be Spanish red it was with the additional option of a black interior. It has never been confirmed but believed to be one of only about 20 cars ever produced with this colour combination.

After 26 years of loyal service and all of 48,000 miles with the passing of her husband, Dorothy decided it was time to pass the "Red Rocket " on to her two grandsons who had always loved it.

After a brief stint with the elder brother the entire Ht's driveline had suffered from some over eager teenage driving and was bought out by the younger brother. (me)

The decision was made to re do and upgrade the entire driveline whilst maintaining the original interior and exterior appearance of the car which is how it remains today.


